This application must be filed with the chief of police no later than 48 hours prior to the start of this activity. The Chief of Police has the authority to ask for any additional information he finds necessary to make a fair determination as whether a permit for such hay ride should be issued. The Chief of Police also has the authority, where good cause is shown, to consider any application for a hay ride that is filed less than 48 hours before the date of the proposed parade.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE OF A HAY RIDE PERMIT

IF A TRAILER IS USED TO TRANSPORT ANY PASSENGERS, A SECOND VEHICLE (ESCORT VEHICLE) MUST FOLLOW THE TOWING VEHICLE AT A SAFE DISTANCE. BOTH THE TOWING VEHICLE AND THE ESCORT VEHICLE MUST DRIVE WITH THEIR EMERGENCY FLASHERS ACTIVATED SO AS TO WARN ALL APPROACHING VEHICLES.

THE TRAILER MUST BE CURRENTLY LICENSED AND EQUIPPED WITH PROPER LIGHTING EQUIPMENT (TURN SIGNALS, BRAKE LIGHTS, AND RUNNING LIGHTS).

PASSENGERS MUST NOT BE PERMITTED TO STAND WHILE THE TOWING VEHICLE AND/OR TRAILER IS IN MOTION.

PASSENGERS MUST NOT BE PERMITTED TO THROW ANYTHING FROM THE TOWING VEHICLE AND/OR TRAILER.

THE TOWING VEHICLE AND/OR TRAILER MUST NOT BE PERMITTED TO STOP IN THE ROADWAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING PASSENGERS TO GET ON OR GET OFF OF THE TOWING VEHICLE AND/OR TRAILER.

I, the undersigned applicant, hereby affirm that the information contained in this application is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that any false or misleading statement in this application is grounds for denial of a permit, or if one has already been issued, grounds for its revocation. I also understand that I am responsible for compliance with all applicable laws and any other requirements set forth for the issuance of this permit.

I hereby save and hold harmless the City of Lockhart and its employees, from all liability, of any nature, including costs and expenses for, or on account of, any claims, demands, suits, or damages of any character whatsoever resulting from injuries or damages sustained by myself or any other person participating in the above hay ride.

I understand that the issuance of this permit does not exempt me from the law (TRC 545.414) that prohibits the operation of an open-bed pickup truck or an open flatbed trailer when a child younger than 18 years of age is occupying the bed of the truck or trailer. This permit merely provides me with a defense to prosecution.
