Voluntary Curbside Single Stream Recycling Service

- Program becomes effective October 1, 2009.
- In order for curbside collection to begin, at least 175 customers must subscribe.
- If at least 175 customers do not subscribe by September 1, 2009, curbside collection will not begin. However, if at some time after September 1, 2009 at least 175 customers subscribe, curbside collection will begin within 30 days.
- If at any point after curbside collection begins, the number of subscribers drops below 175, curbside collection rates will be adjusted or consideration given to stop the service.
- Curbside Single Stream Recycling is **voluntary**, Lockhart utility customers are not required to subscribe to the program.
- If approved by the Lockhart City Council, subscribers would be required to make a 12 month (consecutive) commitment to the program. After the 12 months, the subscriber has the option to stop participating in the program or automatically renew their subscription for an additional 12 months. The 12 months begin with the first month of curbside collection.
- FEE (based on 175 subscribers): \$5.94 per month (a subscriber will be required to pay this fee regardless if they placed recyclable items at the curb that month). Once collection begins, the subscriber will be required to pay this fee for 12 consecutive months. The fee will be included with the subscriber's Lockhart Utility Bill.
- Each subscriber will receive one 18 gallon open top green recycling bin to place at the curb on collection day as well as further instructions on how to participate in the program.
- Accepted recyclables will be collected once per week on Wednesdays.

What's accepted?

- Cardboard and boxboard that is bundled and less than 1/4 cubic yard.
- Tin, steel and aluminum cans that are rinsed out.
- Clear, milk, and soda plastic containers that are rinsed out and have caps/lids removed. (This includes any plastic bottles that show a 1—7 on the bottom)
- Newspaper, magazines, office paper, computer paper, and phone books containerized and/or bundled.

Who can subscribe?

- Residential City of Lockhart Customers.
- Only Account Holder(s) of the utility account may subscribe to a 12 month commitment.
