

What is “Curbside Single Stream Recycling?”

A method of collecting recyclable items right from the curb! Items do not have to be pre-sorted into separate bins, simply place the items in the cart provided to you and take it to the curb. That's it!

How do I sign up?

Complete and return the enclosed form to City Hall.

Is there a fee ?

\$5.67 per month (currently)

Why Recycle?

Voluntary Curbside Single Stream Recycling Service Customer Commitment Form

- Curbside Single Stream Recycling is **voluntary**, Lockhart utility customers are not required to subscribe to the program.
- Subscribers are required to make a 12 month (consecutive) commitment to the program. After the 12 months, the subscriber has the option to stop participating in the program or automatically renew their subscription for an additional 12 months. The 12 months begin with the first month of curbside collection.
- FEE CURRENTLY \$5.67 per month (a subscriber will be required to pay this fee regardless if they placed recyclable items at the curb that month). Once collection begins, the subscriber will be required to pay this fee for 12 consecutive months. The fee will be included with the subscriber's Lockhart Utility Bill.
- Each subscriber will receive one 95 gallon recycling cart to place at the curb on collection day as well as further instructions on how to participate in the program.
- Accepted recyclables will be collected every other Wednesday of each month.

What's accepted?

- Cardboard and boxboard that is bundled and less than 1/4 cubic yard.
- Tin, steel and aluminum cans that are rinsed out.
- Clear, milk, and soda plastic containers that are rinsed out and have caps/lids removed. (This includes any plastic bottles that show a 1—7 on the bottom)
- Newspaper, magazines, office paper, computer paper, and phone books containerized and/or bundled.

Who can subscribe?

- Residential City of Lockhart Customers.
- Only Account Holder(s) of the utility account may subscribe to a 12 month commitment.
