- 1. Call meeting to order. Chair Ruiz called the committee to order at 7:35 p.m.
- 2. Consider the Minutes of the December 8, 2021, meeting.

Member Peterson moved to approve the minutes as submitted, and Member St. Leger seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 7-0.

3. Consider semi-annual report to City Council concerning the status of implementation of Chapter 31 "Impact Fees" of the Code of Ordinances, and advise of the need to update the ordinance, land use assumptions, capital improvements plan, or impact fees.

Mr. Gibson reviewed the impact fee revenues, expenditures, and account balances for the previous six-month period, and the long-term trends since the City began collecting impact fees. He noted that the committee had already recommended to the City Council that the impact fee land use assumptions, capital improvement plans, and fees should be updated at this time, which would meet the requirement by State law that the City undertake an update every five years unless the City Council determines that it is not necessary. The Council subsequently committed to undertaking that project. Therefore, there was nothing new for the Committee to recommend.

There was discussion.

Member McBride moved to have the Chair of the Impact Fee Advisory Committee forward the semi-annual report to City Council with a recommendation that no further action is necessary other than the previously recommended five-year update. Member St. Leger seconded, and the motion passed by a vote of 7-0.

This meeting of the Impact Advisory Committee will be the first of several with the planning consultants hired to prepare the updated Land Use Assumptions, Capital Improvement Plans, and Impact Fees. Freese and Nichols staff will give a presentation focusing primarily on roadway impact fees and land use assumptions. The presentation is 43 pages (slides), so we want to give you time to review it before the meeting in hopes that it will help expedite the discussion during the meeting. The presentation is in color but would be black and white if copied on paper, so Instead of printing it I will send it to you as an e-mail attachment along with the remainder of the agenda packet. You will then be able to see it in color, and we'll save paper by not copying 12 sets of 43 pages (22 sheets double-sided) for staff and the committee.

The water and wastewater elements of the impact fee update will be prepared by the City's engineering firm, TRC, in Austin. Since the scope of the needed water and wastewater capital improvements is dependent upon the forecasted population and employment growth over the next ten years, they will do most of their work after the draft land use assumptions have been approved by the committee.

A schedule is attached for the Land Use Assumptions and Roadway Impact Fee elements of the update project. The Water and Wastewater elements will be coordinated with this schedule.
