

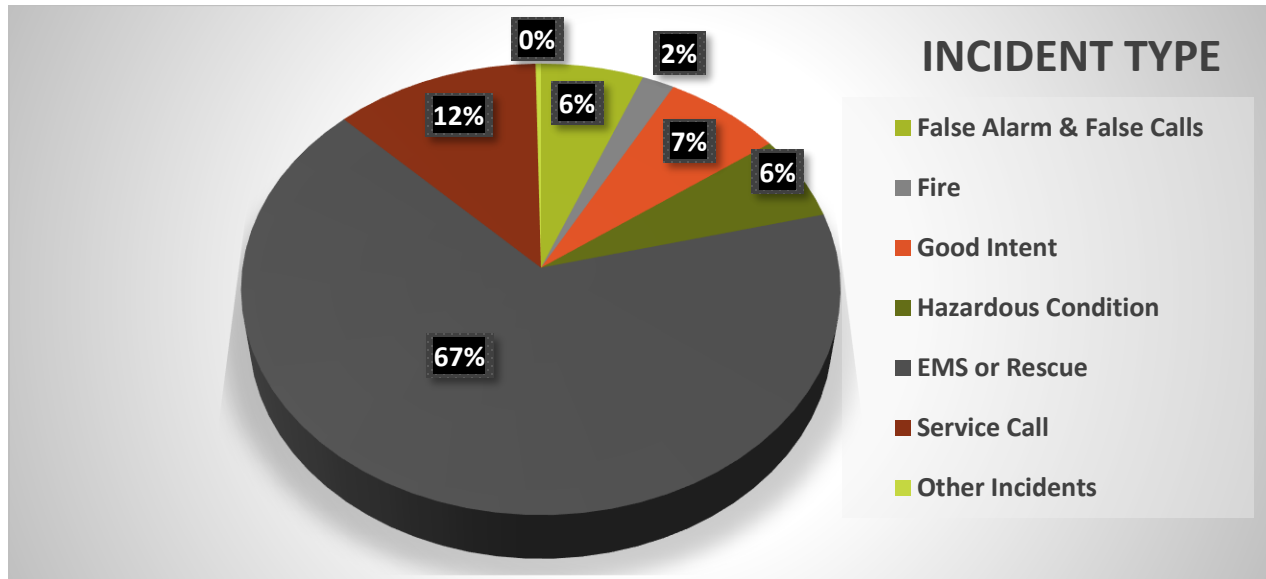

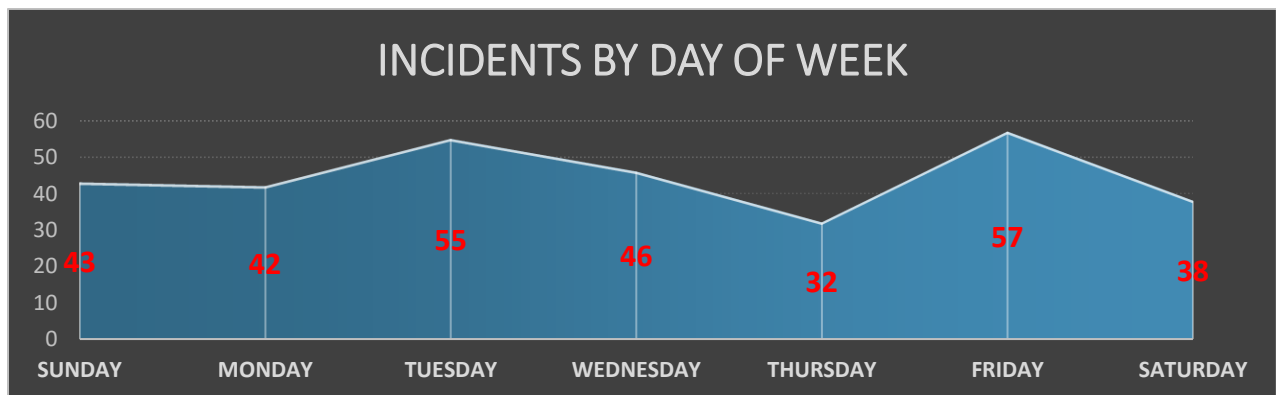
MISSION

The mission of Lockhart Fire Rescue is to serve and protect citizens of our community by providing the highest quality emergency response, community risk reduction, health care, and public safety education

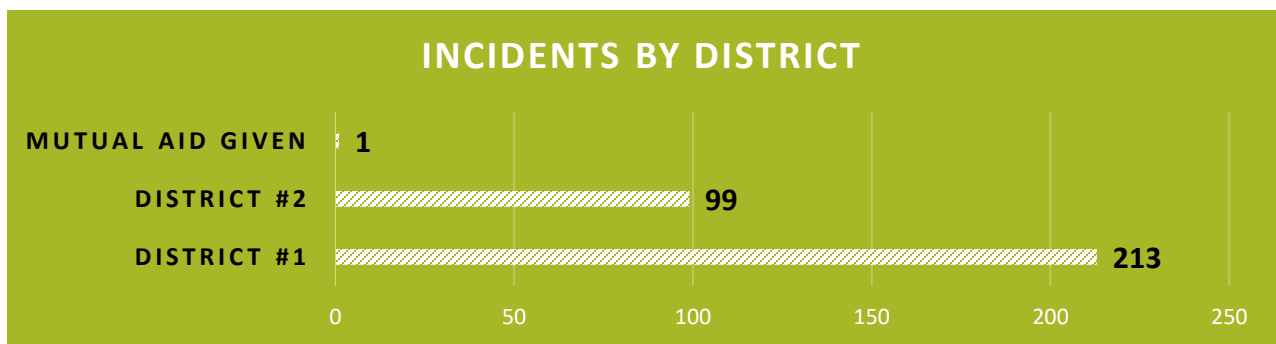

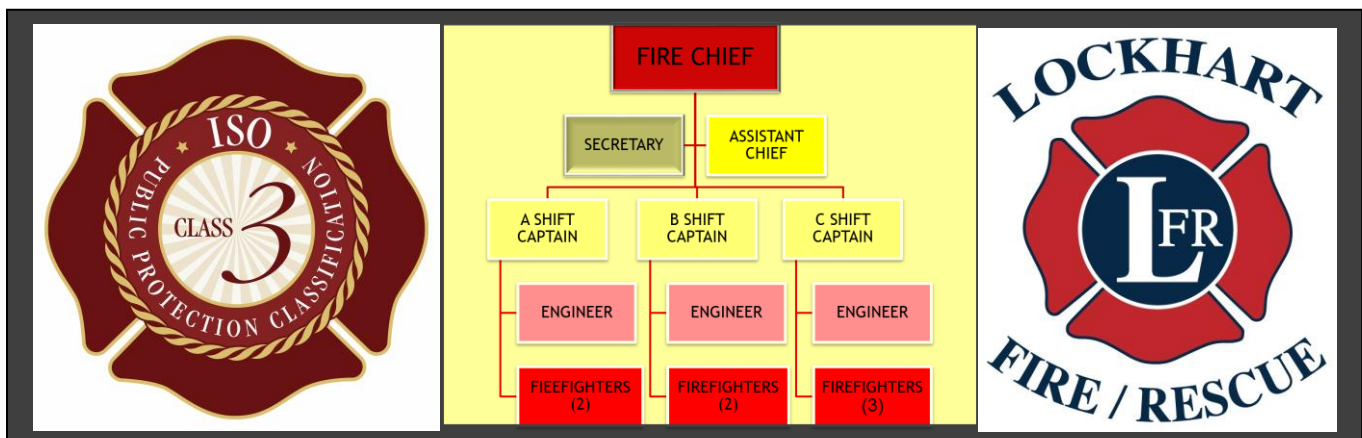

2nd Quarter 2021

April 13th – Annual apparatus pump test and inspection of all Lockhart Fire ground ladders. Engine 4, Engine 2, and Rescue 1 were pump tested and 8 ground ladders for a total of 118’.



May 3rd – Lockhart Fire responded to a structure fire at 1517 Twin Islands at 3:34 a.m. The garage was heavily involved in fire upon fire arrival. All seven residents were able to self-evacuate upon receiving early warning from smoke detectors.

May 21st – Lockhart Fire responded to a structure fire at Club Mira Mar at 838 N. Pecos St. at 6:21 a.m. The dance floor area of the club sustained heavy fire damage. Mutual-aid was received from Mid-County and Travis County ESD #11 fire departments.

June 2nd – Lockhart Fire had training for all three shifts at the training field using a shipping container prop. The scenario was firefighter Mayday operations, self-rescue, and RIT operations.



June 10th – Lockhart Fire participated in the Chisholm Trail Roundup parade and did first-aid standby for the three days of the Chisholm Trail Roundup.



June 28th – A 25 KW generator was installed at Fire Station #2. The generator was purchased through the CARES Act Funds and will provide emergency power during power outages.
