4th Quarter 2021

November 5th – Push-In ceremony at Fire Station #1 to place into service a 2021 Pierce custom fire apparatus. The new pumper has a 1,500 gpm fire pump, 750 gallons of water, class A foam system, ground ladders, deck gun, ground master stream, four preconnected handlines, large 1000' diameter hose and a thermal imager.











4th Quarter 2021

November 30th – Lockhart Fire responded to a fire in a commercial building at 1400 Blackjack, Visionary Fibers. The fire was ignited by a short in a heating blanket. The fire was extinguished by one sprinkler head activating.



December 7th & 16th – MES Fire Equipment sponsored a vehicle extrication class at Lockhart Fire training field using Hurst E-Hydraulics extrication tools. The instructor Kirby Wilson. The vehicles were provided by Statewide Environmental, JR Auto Glass, and Quantum Towing.
