



Goal: Turnout in 1 Minute and 20 Seconds or Less for 90% of Emergency Incidents



August 3^{rd} thru 6^{th} – Annual continuing education training for response to Wildland Fires. Emphasis on strategy and tactics and safety.



August 17th – The Fire Department responded to a structure fire on Mora St. at 23:26. The structure was heavily involved in fire upon arrival. The fire resulted in one civilian fatality and one civilian injury. The State Fire Marshal's Office assisted in the fire investigation.







August 20th – Fire department completed annual PPE cleaning and inspection as required by the Texas commission on Fire Protection (TCFP).



August 28th – Lockhart Fire held an entrance exam for the position of Probationary Firefighter. Four applicants took the written exam and two successfully completed the written and physical ability test.
