

1st Quarter 2022

January 19th – Lockhart Fire responded to a camper fire with exposure to a garage. No injuries.



**January 21**<sup>st</sup> – Lochart Fire responded to a structure fire involving the exterior of a home and stacked firewood.



**February 13<sup>th</sup>** – Lockhart Fire responded to a manufactured home with heavy fire on the front porch. No injuries.



### 1st Quarter

**February 19<sup>th</sup>** – Fire crews attended a health fair at the Old Carver High School at 1104 E. Market St. They displayed their fire apparatus and spoke about fire safety.



**February 23<sup>rd</sup>** – Lockhart Fire received a \$20,000 Texas A&M Forest Service Grant for new a washer/extractor at Fire Station #2 to clean firefighter protective gear. Wildland protective clothing was also purchased to respond to wildland fires within the City of Lockhart.




### 1st Quarter 2022
