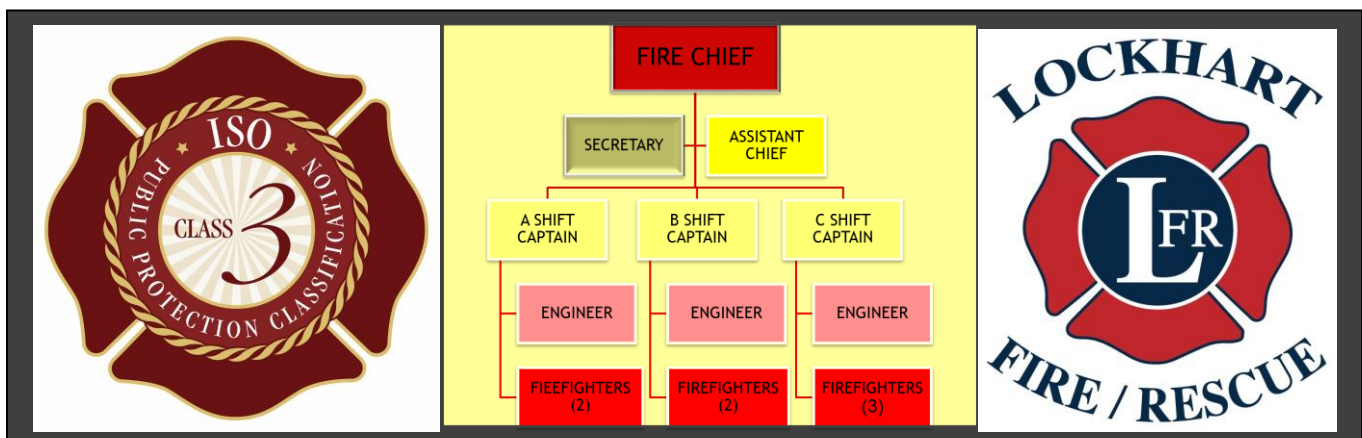

2nd Quarter 2020

- **March/April** – Fire Rescue completed annual testing on approximately 7,800 feet of fire hose.



- **April** – Fire Rescue completed annual maintenance on 750 fire hydrants.



- **May** – Fire Rescue completed annual fire apparatus pump and ground ladder testing.



- **May 6, 2020** – Fire Chief Randy Jenkins obtained Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) Certifications for Intermediate Fire Investigator, Plan Examiner I, and Advanced Fire Inspector.
