




MISSION

CALL VOLUME BY INCIDENT TYPE - 480 TOTAL







COMMON INCIDENT TYPES






AVERAGE FIRST APPARATUS TRAVEL TIME



AVERAGE TURN-OUT TIME BY APPARATUS



June 16^{th} – The asbestos and lead paint abatement began on the Fire Station #1 renovation.








