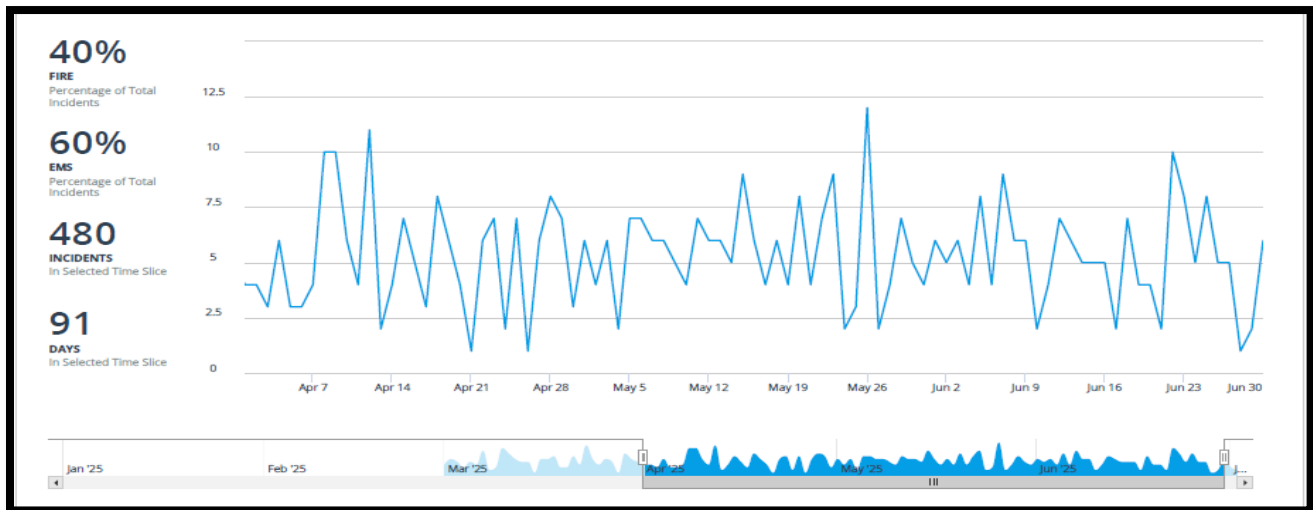

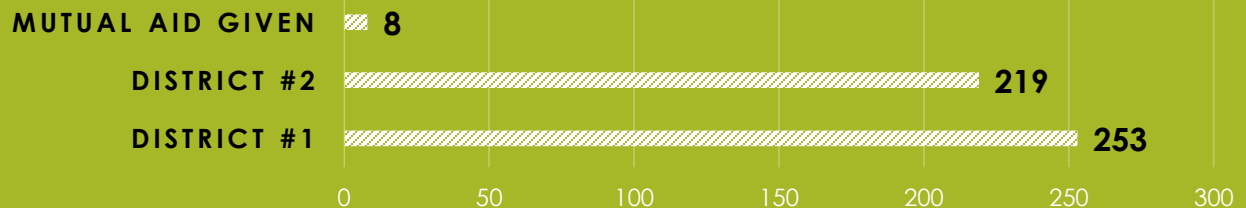
MISSION

INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT



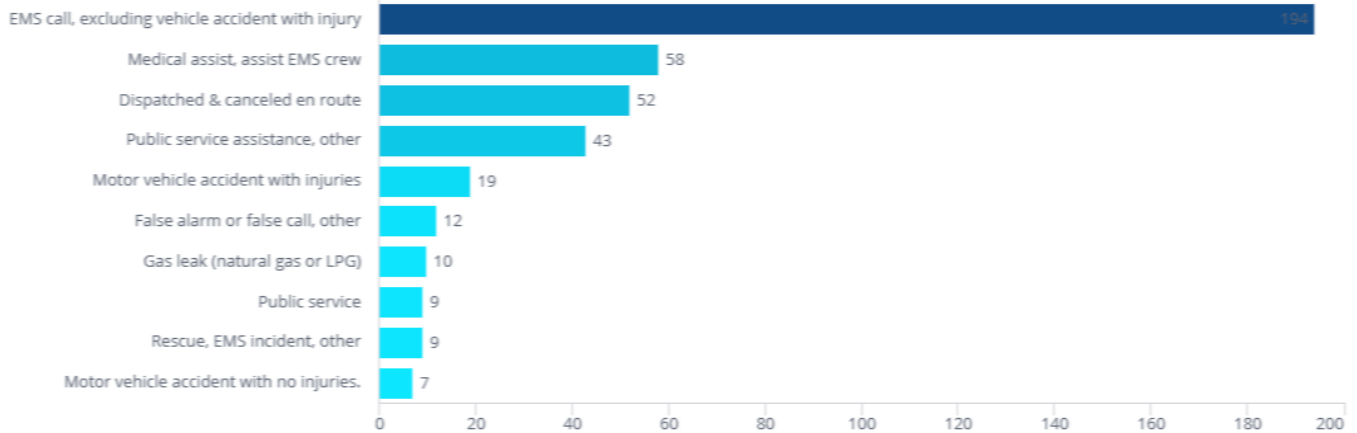

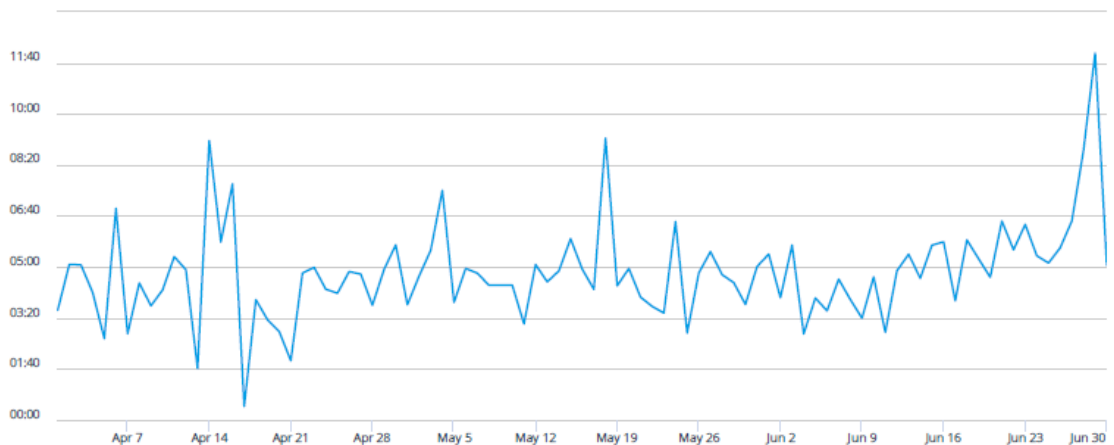

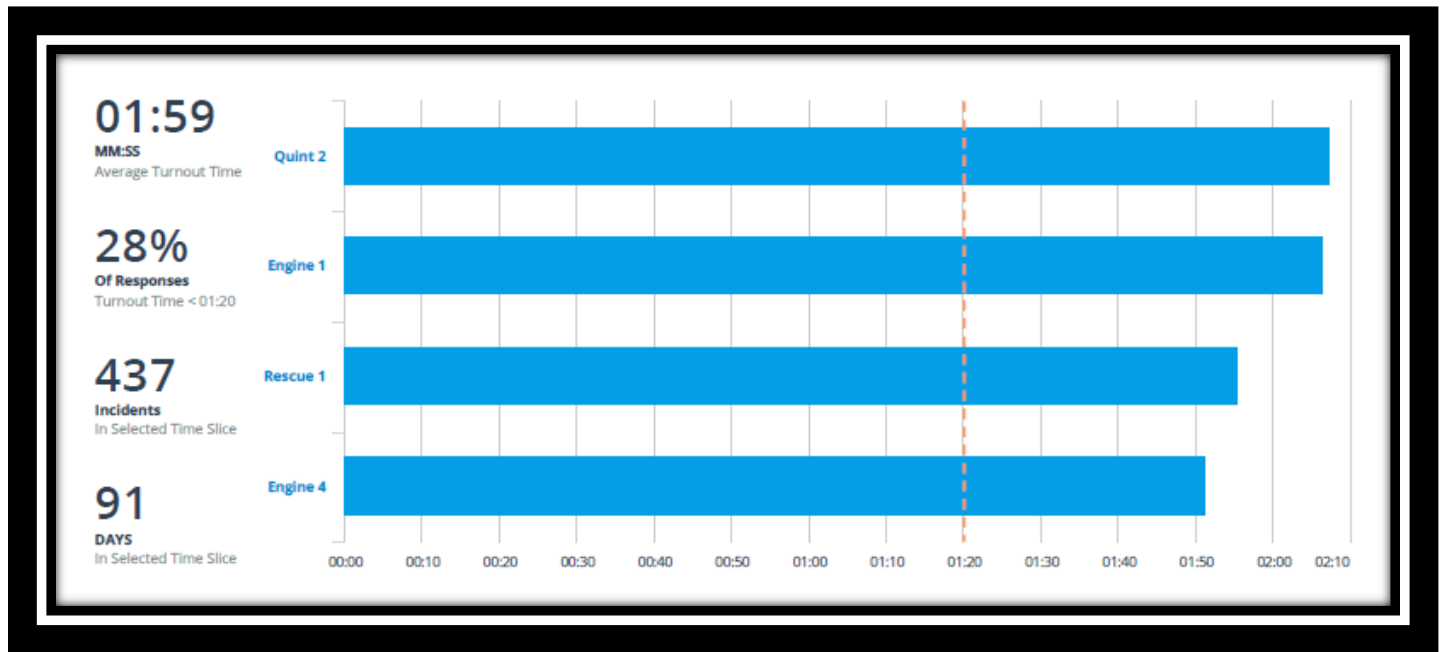

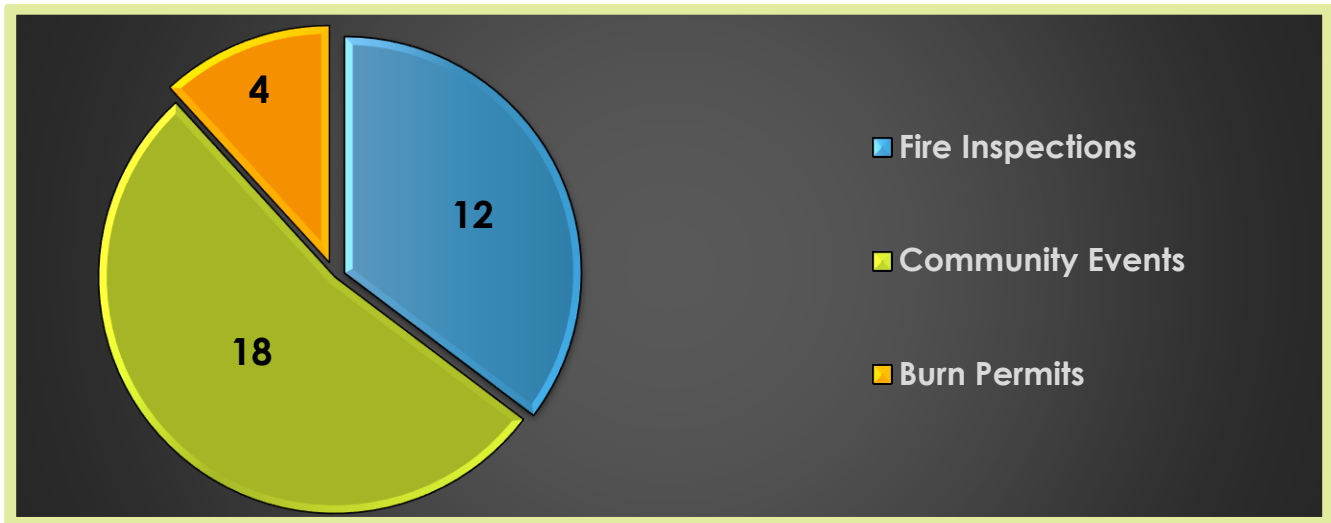
AVERAGE TURN-OUT TIME BY APPARATUS

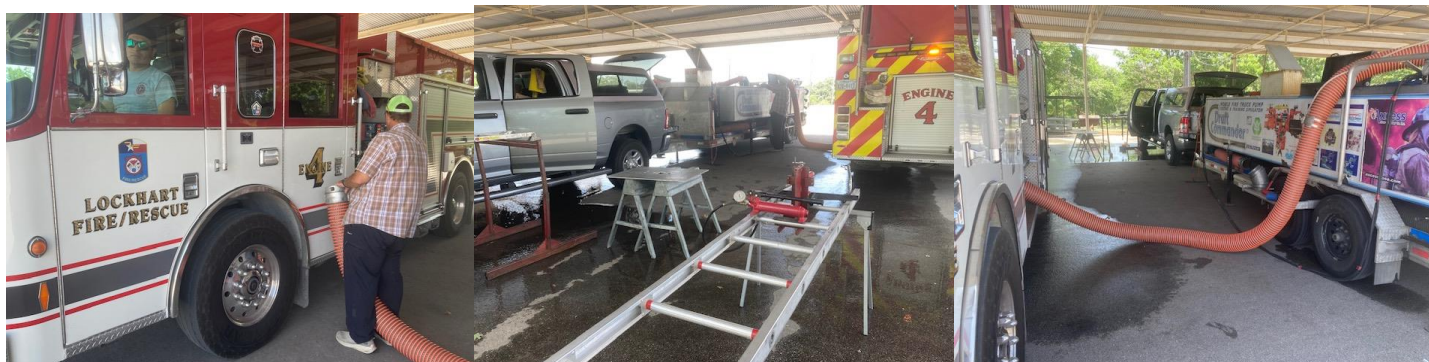

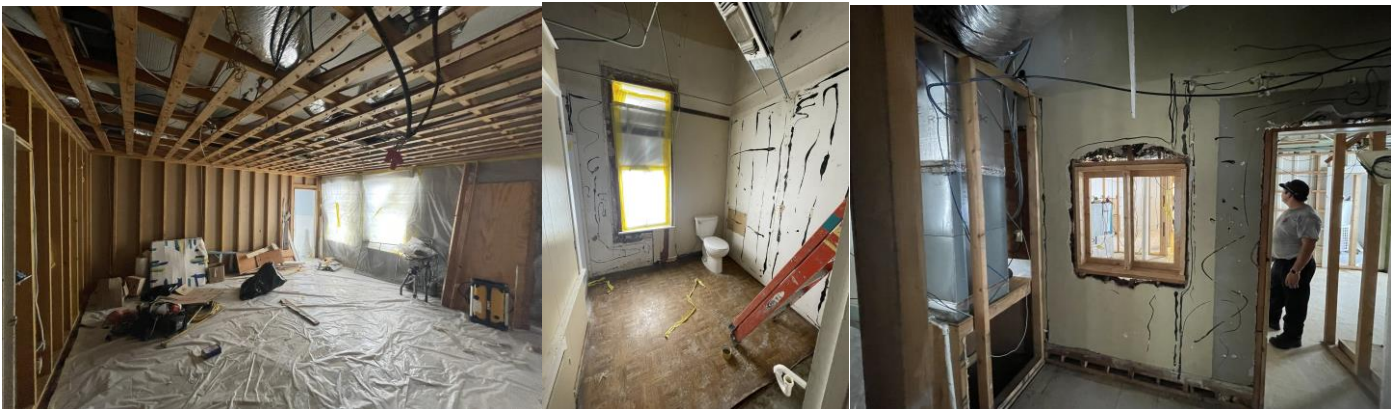

June 16th – The asbestos and lead paint abatement began on the Fire Station #1 renovation.



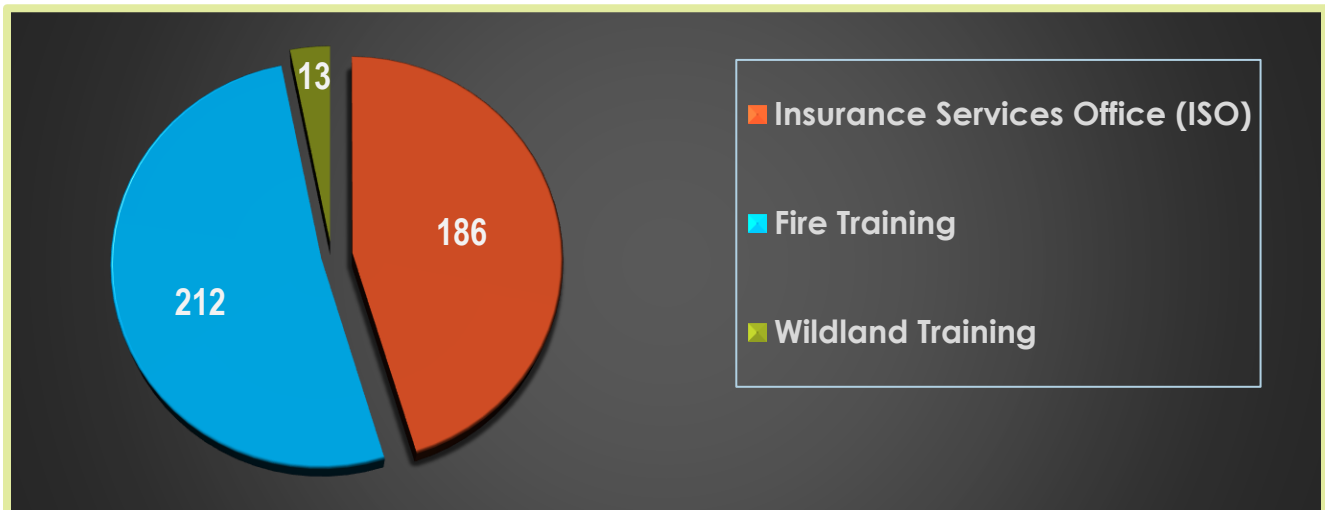

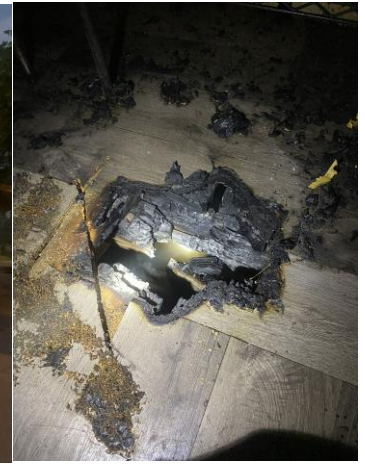
