We encourage the public to interact with our posts and to start constructive dialogue as it pertains to the topic being discussed. City of Lockhart does not tolerate and will remove comments in violation of the [Facebook Community Standards](#) including:

- Misleading information or false claims;
- Vulgar or abusive language;
- Personal or obscene attacks of any kind;
- Offensive terms targeting individuals or groups based on gender, race, ethnicity, nationality, religion or sexual orientation;
- Threats or defamatory statements;
- Links to any site;
- Suggestions or encouragement of illegal activity;
- Multiple successive off-topic posts, repetitive posts, or spam;
- Harassment and bullying of City of Lockhart employees and other page commenters;
- Unsolicited proposals or other business ideas;
- Promotion or endorsement of commercial services, products, or unrelated entities.

Repeatedly failing to comply with the City of Lockhart Social Media Comments Policy may result in the commenter being blocked from City of Lockhart's Social Media Platforms.
